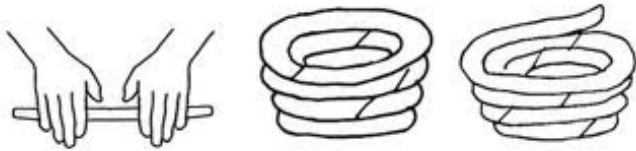

Making Pottery

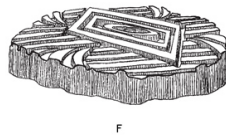
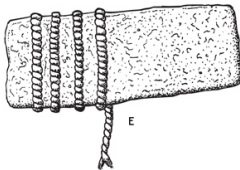
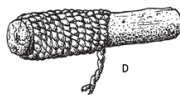
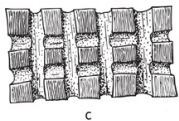
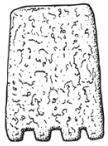
COILING

Made by rolling long pieces and then stacking them.



PINCHING

Made by pinching and shaping between your fingers.



USING A PADDLE

Native Americans would use different materials to make designs in their pottery. They would wrap cord or carve stamps then push them into the wet clay to make a design.
